
Rules And Regulations

- A resident of WNE who has chosen not to be a recreational member **MAY NOT** be a guest of a resident who is a recreational member. **No exceptions.** To restate that: if you are a recreational member, you **MAY NOT** bring another WNE resident as a guest to the pool. **No exceptions.**
- Rec member children under the age of 14 years old must have an adult with them to supervise them. Fourteen years old and over may come alone but must exhibit good behavior.

Important Information for Recreational Members

For the 2023 pool season, Wellington Northeast is partnering with a new pool company called Pyle's Pools of Indianapolis. We are hopeful they will work out as well (or better) than previous companies we have worked with.

Dates & Hours of Operation

The pools will be open on the following days:

- North Pool (No Lifeguard): May 26, 2023 – September 24, 2023
- South Pool (No Lifeguard): May 26, 2023 – September 5, 2023

The pools are to be open during the following hours:

- Daily (including holidays): 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. (except during cold or inclement weather)
- Daily (including holidays): 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. for lap swim for to those that specifically sign-up.

Changes to Pool Operations

- The Pool will continue to have NO LIFEGUARDS for the entire pool season. Indiana state law requires children under 14 years to be accompanied and supervised by an adult at pools without lifeguards. This means everyone who uses the pool will swim at their own risk. We will be providing new “swim at your own risk” signs to place in the pool area.
- The north Pools will, be open later in the year until September 24, 2023. We hope this will give people more time to enjoy the pools and the beautiful weather we often have during fall.

Please note that these changes were made after much debate and consideration at our Executive Committee meeting in 2022.

Pool Rental

We will accept pool party reservations for dates from May 30 (the Tuesday after Memorial Day) until July 31. Evening pool parties are bookable at either the North or South Pool for the last three hours the pool is open, from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. The fee is \$200 Monday thru Thursday and \$250 Friday thru Sunday. In addition, for the 2023 season we will be accepting morning pool parties at either pool for 9:00am to 1:00pm. The cost for morning pool parties will be \$400 Monday thru Friday and \$500 Saturday or Sunday. Please note the following rules:

1. Evening pool parties must be booked at least three weeks prior to the date desired to allow us to secure Lifeguards through our pool manager. Morning pool parties must be booked six weeks prior to the date desired due to the demand for Lifeguards during the day.
2. All pool parties must have Lifeguards. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
3. Pool parties will not be allowed on a holiday weekend.

Tennis Courts

Like last year, we will have a code for recreational members who want to use the tennis courts. You will receive this code via email if you pay recreational dues for the year.

Recreational Membership Reminder

Just like in prior years, you will not have access to the pools or tennis courts if you do not pay recreational membership dues and they have been received by our accounting service. **You are also prohibited from being a guest at the pool or tennis courts if you are a neighborhood resident.** If you are at the pool or using the tennis courts without a recreational membership, you will be asked to leave. There will be no exceptions.

As with last year, we will be using entry cards for the gates. Only one card will be issued per household. Existing recreational members will use their existing cards. A card for a new recreational member will be issued after the fee is recorded by our accounting service and the Pool Committee Chairman is notified. This process generally takes approximately seven days. Please plan ahead to ensure that you have access to our beautiful pool facilities. We do not have the ability to respond to emergency requests.

Last, lost or stolen cards will be replaced at a cost of \$25 and the new card will not be issued until our accounting service notifies the Chairman of the Pool Committee. As noted, this process takes approximately seven days. We want to encourage you to check to see that you have your card.
